


Law Entrance Exams: What do they test?

Law entrance tests are designed to evaluate your worth as a potential lawyer and they consist of various sections to analyse your skill levels. The selection process at most institutes is by written examination.

The written tests are usually 2 hours duration with multiplechoice questions and negative marking for incorrect answers.

- English: Tests your vocabulary, word usage, grammar and verbal reasoning skills. Evaluates your ability to assimilate and comprehend formal written English
- Quantitative Ability: Tests your fundamental understanding of Mathematics (up to X Std. level)
- Analytical and Critical Reasoning: Assesses your ability to process data and arrive at logical conclusions
- General Knowledge/ General Awareness

3-year LLB vis-à-vis 5-year LLB

How good is a three-year LLB versus a 5-year integrated law program? We have been asked this question by a large number of students. The answer is very simple. Both courses are equally good and they should not be compared in the first place simply because they serve to two different audiences. If a candidate is a Class 12 student or has already passed out, he should go for five-year law without giving any thought to the three-year course in future. The LLB course is now available in two formats for two different audiences - 5-year integrated LLB course for Class 12 pass-outs and a 3-year LLB course for graduates of any stream. The advantage is that those who miss the bus after Class 12 due to various reasons still have an opportunity to study law after graduation.

How do you get into India's Top Law Schools?

Admission into top National Law school is based on the Common Law Aptitude Test(CLAT) conducted by the NLUs. This makes the CLAT the holy grail for every law aspirants. Some of the major entrance tests are:

- Common Law Admission Test(CLAT): This is conducted by NLUs. Prominent Law Schools that accept the CLAT score include the 17 NLU's.
- All India Law Entrance Test (AILET) is being conducted by National Law University Delhi for admissions into undergraduate and post graduate law programmes.
- Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) is a common written test for the admission processes of undergraduate Institutes of Symbiosis International University.
- IPU CET is the Common Entrance Test conducted by Guru Govind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU) for providing admission to various undergraduate engineering programmes in the University.
- KLSAT Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT) conducts KLSAT 2016 for admissions to undergraduate lawprogrammes including BALLB, B.Sc LLB and BBALLB.
- LSAT-India is an all India entrance test designed by the Law School Admission Council (LSAC), USA and is conducted by Pearson VUE, LSAC's Affiliate.
- UPES Law Studies Aptitude Test (ULSAT) is conducted by the University of Petroleum and Energy Studies (UPES). The competitive entrance test is conducted to grant admission to Bachelor of Laws (B.A.LLB) and LLB in Corporate Laws, Cyber Laws and Intellectual Property Rights.
- AIL Entrance Test 2017 is the university level undergraduate entrance exam for admissions to law programmes in Army Institute of Law. The institute offers 80 seats for five-year integrated LLB programmes including BALLB.
- JMI BA LLB Entrance Exam 2017 is the undergraduate law entrance exam for admissions to five year law programmes in Jamia Millia Islamia. The University offers undergraduate five year integrated law programmes including BALLB.

■ What is CLAT? Could you please brief about it?

CLAT stands for Common Law Admission Test for 16 National Law university which offers 5 yr LLB right after class 12th.

Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) is a centralised test for admission to 17 prominent National Law Universities in India. The test is taken after the Higher Secondary Examination or the 12th grade for admission to integrated under graduation programmes in Law and after Graduation in Law for Master of Laws programmes conducted by these law universities. This test was conducted for the first time on 11 May 2008. The two-hour admission test consists of objective type covering questions on Elementary Mathematics or Numerical Ability, English with Comprehension, General knowledge and Current affairs, Legal Aptitude and Logical reasoning. The CLAT scores are used by other private law colleges across the country and Public Sector Undertakings for admissions and recruitment respectively.

How much should I score in CLAT to get admission into best college in India?

CLAT 2016 scheduled to be held in online mode had 200 questions of 200 marks, where every correct answer will be awarded one mark and for every incorrect answer, 0.25 marks will be deducted from the total scored marks, as per the negative marking


The expected cut-off of Online CLAT 2016, as provided by various exam experts is 124 - 130 marks.

What would be the salary we can expect after doing 5 years law course?

It depends on the job profile and the company you're working for. Generally, once you're recognized as good lawyers, there is no dearth of cases for them to fight and expect a salary in 6 - 15 lakhs range.

■ What is the difference between BA LLB and BBALLB?

Both courses are very closely related, but there is quite a bit of difference in terms of the focus of the subject and career opportunities associated with the topics. BA LLB will give you more insight into Humanities + Law. BBA LLB will give you more insight into Management + Law.

My English is not very good but I'm good at Mathematics, so can I prepare for Common Law Admission Test (CLAT)?

Before you make a wrong opinion about yourself that you do not know English so well, understand that written and communication English are two different aspects. Even if you prepare to write twice a week of Essay writing that Success Mantra study will guide, it will improve in a few weeks. Facing the CLAT

■ What are the tips you suggest to score good marks in CLAT?

Start with past papers: It's advisable for every law aspirant to get past papers of CLAT. NLU Delhi. LSAT-India. DU. etc available at the respective law schools on payment or on University website for free in case of DU. Solving the past papers and doing a careful study of them help a law aspirant in two ways: knowing the type of questions in each area and where you are lacking. Make a study plan: Law aspirants must make a daily study plan based on aforementioned information. At least two months of intensive preparation (8 hours of studies daily) is a must to crack an LL.B. Entrance Test like CLAT. Of course, students starting their prep while in class 11 or 12 may take liberty to give a little time for entrance prep throughout the year. Candidates must make a plan where they study at least 2 subjects every day and have at least one vocabulary/English and one reasoning exercise daily.

Take help of coaching institutes: As per an internal study at a top law school few years back, more than 80% of the students present in the law school took some coaching or other. A good distance learning course or classroom training programme or even a mock test series can make a huge difference to your preparations. 

- There are 3 Centers of Faculty of law though all the three Centres are a part of the Faculty of Law, University of Delhi, each has its separate teaching and non-teaching staff.
- Established in the year 1970, Campus Law Centre is a premier unit under the aegis of the Faculty of Law, University of Delhi.
- Law Centre-I is presently working from 9:40 a.m. to 5:55 p.m. (in two shifts). There is an Evening shift from 5.55 p.m.-9.35 p.m. (allotment being subject to availability of seats). Law centre-I, like the other Law Centres, conducts 'full time' LL.B Programme (3 years or 6 semesters) only.
- Law Centre-II, also caters to the office going, employed public who find it difficult to take time out in the mornings. Classes are held in Evening Shift from 5:55 9:35 PM, for six days a week. The students are free to opt for either session (allotment being subject to availability of seats). Every year 1002 students are admitted to first year LL.B. Course in Law Centre-1 selected on the basis of the Common Entrance Test conducted by the Faculty of Law, University of Delhi.


