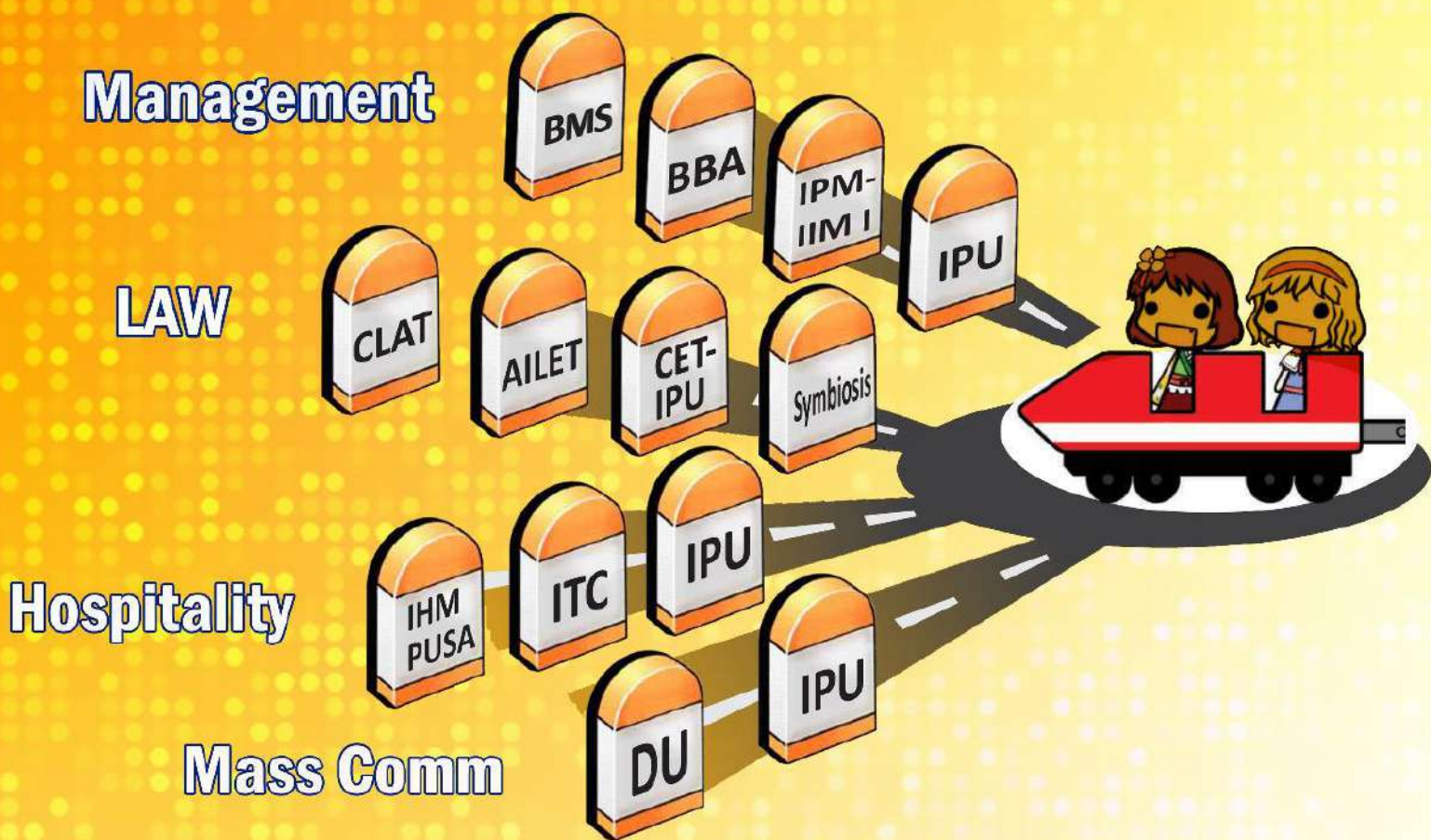

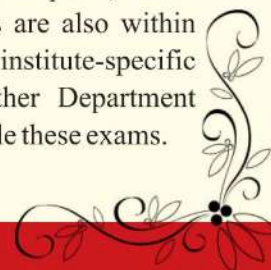

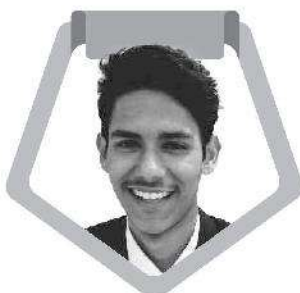

Any difference between BBA, BBM & BMS?

BBA stands for Bachelor of Business Administration, BBM stands for Bachelor of Business Management and BMS stands for Bachelor of Management Studies. These courses are more or less the same and some universities give the name as BBA and some universities give the name as BBM or BMS. However, as far as brand name is concerned BMS (Delhi University) is better than BBM or BBA.

All these courses are management courses. Studies of BMS course concentrate on analytical and logical aspects, while BBA course concentrates on core studies. Both the graduates of BBA and BMS can take up MBA after completion of the under-graduation course or they can even take up management trainee position in a company of repute.

Degree: B.El.Ed. (Only for Girls)

The Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) programme is a four-year integrated professional degree programme of Elementary Teacher Education (Only for Girls) offered after the senior secondary (class XII) stage of school. The programme aims to produce graduates of high caliber in the field of teacher education.

At present, the programme is being offered in eight (8) women colleges of the University of Delhi.

1. Aditi Mahavidyalaya
2. Gargi College
3. Institute of Home Economics
4. Jesus & Mary College
5. Lady Shri Ram College for Women
6. Mata Sundri College
7. Miranda House
8. Shyama Prasad Mukherji College

Over 3000 students have already graduated from these colleges since 1998. A good number of them have been placed in government and private schools as professionally qualified elementary school teachers.

Career Prospects

Some of the professional and academic opportunities available for B.El.Ed. graduates are:

1. Teaching in elementary schools (Classes I to VIII): B.El.Ed. graduates are eligible for recruitment as teachers in MCD/NDMC/ Sarvodaya Vidyalayas in Delhi as well as in Kendriya Vidyalayas and Navodaya Vidyalayas across India, and in private schools.
2. Leading the elementary school systems in various capacities.
3. Teaching and research in elementary education in government and nongovernment sectors.

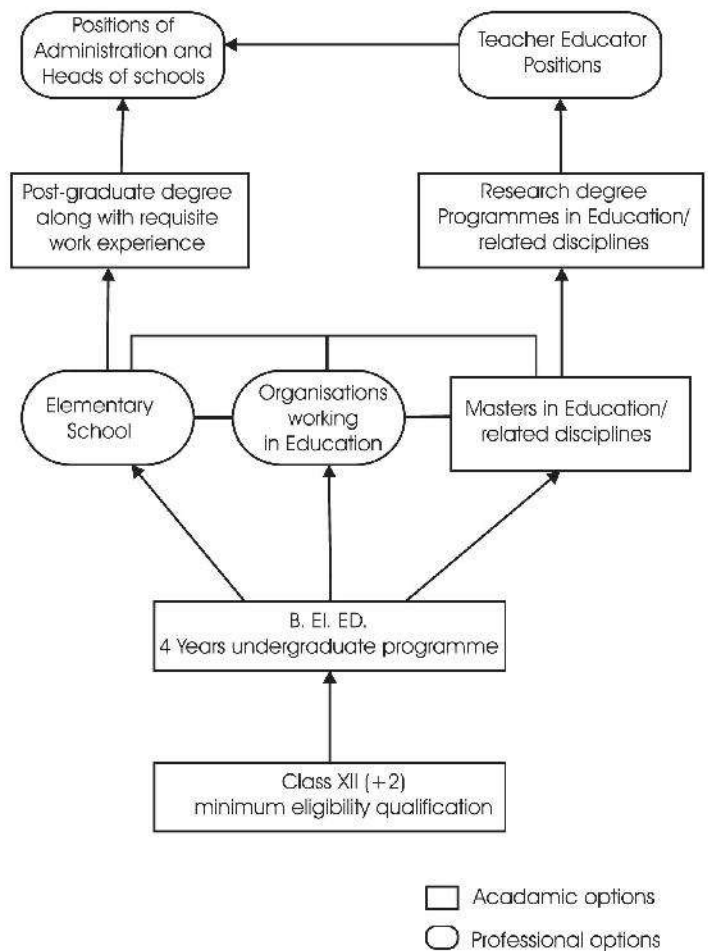

Degree: BCA/ B.Sc. Computer Science

Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) is a 3 years undergraduate program (divided in 6 semesters) in Computer Applications. In the recent years, BCA has emerged as one of the in-demand vocational courses. This course focuses on preparing students for roles pertaining to Computer Applications and IT industry. The course helps a student develop programming skills, networking skills and learn application packages, programming languages and modern techniques of Information technology.

Why BCA is A Good Career Option

In the recent years, BCA has emerged as one of the in-demand vocational courses. It can provide a number of job opportunities and has a good career scope for the candidates. The various kind of job opportunities for the candidates soon after the completion of their BCA course are

- Database Administrator
- Web Programmer
- Software Programmer

Initially the candidates are going to paid an amount of Rs. 15000 to Rs. 18000 as a Fresher. Once they get experience, they will be paid high salaries.

In order to get more salaries, One can do MCA course or some other certification courses.

Any difference between BCA & B.Sc. in Computer Science?

There is not much difference between BCA and B.Sc. in Computer Science except that the former is more professionally inclined. In BCA a student learns mainly about operating systems, DBMS, Digital Electronics and other areas of Information Technology. BCA, as a course, seeks to bridge

the gap between business and technology. In BCA, focus is on the technological aspect of computer applications.

On the other hand, Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Computer Science is a theory based paper and deals in both hardware and software part of computer. In this course, a student can learn soft computing skills and mathematical and theoretical concepts related to computers.

Career Prospects

After completing the BCA course students can start as Junior Programmer or a Software Tester and then move higher up the ranks and attain the role of a Senior Programmer.

IT industry is booming in India and even in times of global recession, the Indian scene was relatively stable. While BCA gives students a solid grounding in technology theory, career wise, you're more likely to find your competitive edge by completing your MCA.

- 1) The job opportunities exists in Government Sectors (Armed Forces, Nationalized Banks, PSUs e.t.c.) as well.
- 2) When it comes to Private sector, Software MNCs (like Infosys, TCS, Google, Tech-Mahendra, Patni, WIPRO) are the prime recruiters. Web hosting, IT sector, Electronics Industry are some other sectors that recruits BCA. graduates.
- 3) Graduates may also become self employed, by becoming freelance or independent software developers, software security experts, consultants etc.

3-year LLB vis-à-vis 5-year LLB:

How good is a three-year LLB versus a 5-year integrated law program? We have been asked this question by a large number of students. The answer is very simple. Both courses are equally good and they should not be compared in the first place simply because they serve to two different audiences. If a candidate is a Class 12 student or has already passed out, he should go for five-year law without giving any thought to the three-year course in future. The LLB course is now available in two formats for two different audiences - 5-year integrated LLB course for Class 12 pass-outs and a 3-year LLB course for graduates of any stream. The advantage is that those who miss the bus after Class 12 due to various reasons still have an opportunity to study law after graduation.

How do you get into India's Top Law Schools?

Admission into top National Law school is based on the Common Law Aptitude Test (CLAT) conducted by the NLUs. This makes the CLAT the holy grail for every law aspirants. Some of the major entrance tests are:

- 1) Common Law Admission Test (CLAT): This is conducted by NLUs. Prominent Law Schools that accept the CLAT score include the 21 NLU's.
- 2) All India Law Entrance Test (AILET) is being conducted by National Law University Delhi for admissions into undergraduate and post graduate law programmes.
- 3) Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) is a common written test for

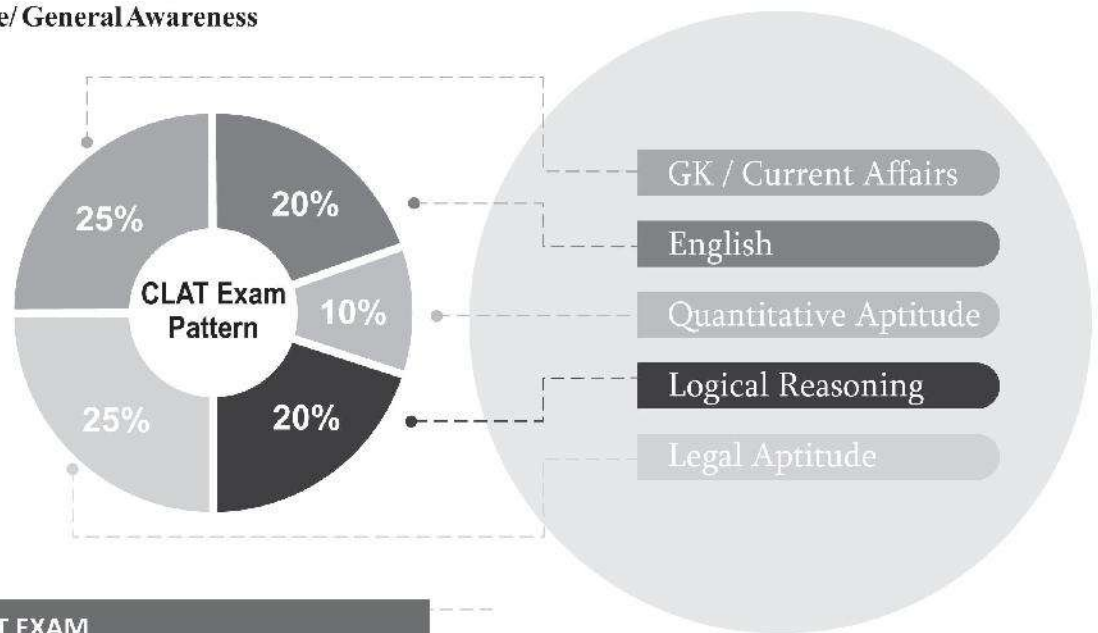
- the admission processes of undergraduate Institutes of Symbiosis International University.
- 4) IPU CET is the Common Entrance Test conducted by Guru Govind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU) for providing admission to various undergraduate engineering programmes in the University.
- 5) KLSAT - Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT) conducts KLSAT 2019 for admissions to undergraduate law programmes including BA LLB, B.Sc LLB and BBA LLB.
- 6) LSAT-India is an all India entrance test designed by the Law School Admission Council (LSAC), USA and is conducted by Pearson VUE, LSAC's Affiliate.
- 7) UPES Law Studies Aptitude Test (ULSAT) is conducted by the University of Petroleum and Energy Studies (UPES). The competitive entrance test is conducted to grant admission to Bachelor of Laws (B.A.LLB) and LLB in Corporate Laws, Cyber Laws and Intellectual Property Rights.
- 8) AIL Entrance Test 2019 is the university level undergraduate entrance exam for admissions to law programmes in Army Institute of Law. The institute offers 80 seats for five-year integrated LLB programmes including BA LLB.
- 9) JMI BA LLB Entrance Exam 2019 is the undergraduate law entrance exam for admissions to five year law programmes in Jamia Millia Islamia. The University offers undergraduate five year integrated law programmes including BA LLB.

Law Entrance Exams: What do they test?

Law entrance tests are designed to evaluate your worth as a potential lawyer and they consist of various sections to analyse your skill levels. The selection process at most institutes is by written examination.

The written tests are usually 2 hours duration with multiple-choice questions and negative marking for incorrect answers.

- **English:** Tests your vocabulary, word usage, grammar and verbal reasoning skills. Evaluates your ability to assimilate and comprehend formal written English
- **Quantitative Ability:** Tests your fundamental understanding of Mathematics (up to X Std. level)
- **Analytical and Critical Reasoning:** Assesses your ability to process data and arrive at logical conclusions
- **General Knowledge/General Awareness**
- **Legal Aptitude**
