1 Arrive Split

Arrive Split, a town on Croatia's Dalmatian Coast, is known for its beaches and the fortress like complex at its centre, Diocletian's Palace, erected by the Roman emperor in the 4th century. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel. Afternoon is at leisure or you may opt for a private walking tour of the city.

Overnight at the hotel.

2 Split/Hvar

Breakfast at the hotel. You will be transferred from the hotel to the port of Split, to board the catamaran from Split to Hvar, the island in Adriatic Sea, is the longest and the sunniest Croatian island and one of the most beautiful islands in the world. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

3 Hvar

Breakfast at the hotel. Sunny Hvar, as the slogan reads, is characterised by gentle winters, warm summers and many hours of sunshine. You will be amazed to see how the lavender fields and the vineyards stripe the bare Mediterranean landscape, descending gradually from black pine woods to white stoned bays. Enjoy the day at leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

4 Hvar/Brac

Early morning transfer from the hotel to Jelsa port in Hvar to embark to the catamaran to Bol on Brac Island. Brac is a Croatian island in the Adriatic Sea, best known for the white-pebble beach Zlatni Rat, a favoured windsurfing site outside the resort town of Bol. Seaside Pucišća features traditional architecture and an active quarry for the island's famous white limestone. Upon arrival to Bol, transfer to the hotel. Enjoy the day at leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

5 Brac

Breakfast at the hotel. Day is at leisure in Bol, the oldest settlement in Brac. The famous "Zlatni Rat" beach known as the "Golden Horn" is reputed to be the most beautiful in the Adriatic. Overnight at the hotel.

6 Depart Brac/Split

Early morning transfer from hotel to Bol port, to take the catamaran from Bol (Brac Island) to Split. Upon arrival to Split port you will be free to enjoy the magnificent town of Split with its numerous archaeological, historical and cultural sites on your own. Services end at Split port.
